

## ASPIRE 2026 - Rapid Fire Presentation Guidelines

We are pleased to introduce the **Rapid-Fire Presentation**, a new presentation format that will be launched at the **ASPIRE 2026 Congress**.

This format allows more authors the opportunity to share their research in a short and engaging presentation. Each presenter will briefly highlight the key points of their study so that the audience can learn about a wider range of research within the session.

### Presentation Format

- Each presenter will have **3 minutes** to present their study
- There will be **no Q&A session** following the presentation.
- Presentations are limited to a **maximum of 3 slides**
- Presenters must adhere strictly to the 3-minute time limit. The presentation will be stopped if the allotted time is exceeded.

### Recommended presentation structure:

- Research Question
- Methods and Key Results
- Conclusion and Key Message

### Presentation Tips

- Focus only on the most important findings.
- Avoid excessive text.
- Use clear figures or bullet points where possible.
- Practice beforehand to ensure the presentation fits within 3 minutes.

### Submission of Slides

- Slides must be prepared in PowerPoint format (16:9).
- Please submit your presentation to the Congress Secretariat at [aspire2026-conf@kit-group.org](mailto:aspire2026-conf@kit-group.org) by **30 April**.
- Changes onsite may not be permitted.

### Onsite Instructions

- Presenters should be seated in the session room at least 10 minutes before the session begins.
- When your abstract title appears on screen, proceed to the podium immediately.
- The next presenter should be ready to follow without delay.
